"Collage and assemblage are my primary media. I have explored many subjects over the four decades of my art career. The idea for this particular series began years ago when my cousin was threatened with eviction from her rent controlled NYC apartment. Her landlord complained that her accumulation of clutter was a safety and health hazard. While helping her clean up her place, I got to thinking about my own possessions - my justifications and excuses for collecting and keeping so much stuff.

I have created over 35 assemblages for this series, each with an actual object from the collection recessed in the center and a text that tells the story (the Cautionary Tale) behind each work.

These artworks explore the stuff in my own life and the lives of friends and family - part inventory, part memoir, part confession."
